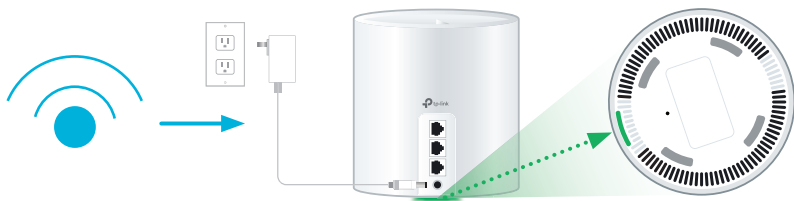


Follow these easy steps to set up your additional Wi-Fi pod(s):

1. Place the additional Wi-Fi pod where you want it and plug it into a power outlet.
2. When the light on the bottom of the Wi-Fi pod is solid green, your additional pod is now connected to your Wi-Fi network. This can take up to 5 minutes.



Check the status of your Pod based on the LED light colour:

-  **Yellow:** Wi-Fi pod unit is starting up.
-  **Blue solid/pulse:** Wi-Fi pod is auto connecting to your network.
-  **Green:** Wi-Fi pod is ready to use.
-  **Red:** Reboot the Wi-Fi pod by unplugging the power adapter. Wait 30 seconds, then plug back in. If red light continues, check your main Wi-Fi pod as it might need to be rebooted by following the same process.

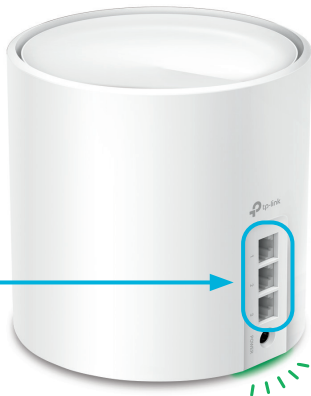
Tip: If you have already downloaded the TP-Link Deco App, the Pod(s) can also be added to your existing Wi-Fi network by pressing the "+" sign in the upper right corner of the home screen.

Connecting Wired Devices

Each Wi-Fi 6 pod is equipped with three ethernet ports

Your modem will take one port on your main Wi-Fi pod. The additional ports or additional Wi-Fi pods can be used to connect a nearby device. For example:

- Home Phone Analog Telephone Adapter (ATA)
- TV Set Top Box
- Gaming Console
- Computer
